

Spiritual Boot Camp Lesson Seven: The Great Commission Discipler Guide



A Vision for Spiritual Generations

And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable men who will also be qualified to teach others." (2 Timothy 2:2, NIV) We see in this passage four generations of Jesus followers. Just as Paul encouraged Timothy to invest in the next generation while teaching them to pass on the Good News to the next generation, we too are called to disciple with future generations in mind.

Memory Verse: Matt. 28:19-20 and review all 7 verses when you meet together

Key Truth: Our call is to follow Jesus and to become disciple makers; not just disciples, but disciple makers! Jesus invested His life into 12 men and even more specifically, three - Peter, James and John. We are charged with following his example!!

Key Illustration: One Verse Evangelism and The Disciple's Testimony

Review what you have learned together covering the key truths from each lesson:

This week concludes your Spiritual Boot Camp experience! It also launches a new phase in your life. You are both a disciple and a disciple maker! As a disciple, you:

- 1. Have assurance of your salvation.
- 2. Interact with and relate personally to God.
- 3. Understand God's special relationship to you and how you are a part of the body of Christ.
- 4. Understand the truth about who Father God is and how He sees you as His child.
- 5. Understand the role of the Holy Spirit in the believer's life and in the Church, and have received His power and authority.
- 6. Are growing in Christ-likeness.
- 7. Live out the Great Commission. Know how to share your story and God's story.

As a disciple yourself, Jesus raises up a new generation of disciples through you (Matthew 28:18–20). Here are the key truths to review:

Lesson 1: Assurance of Salvation

Key Truth: The assurance of my salvation is anchored in God's truth proclaimed in the Word of God, not my own feelings, insights, experiences or traditions.

Lesson 2: Devotional Life

Key Truth: Our new life in Christ is designed for us to grow in closeness with God as we cultivate and prioritize this relationship, daily consuming the Word of God and engaging in the Divine dialogue.

Lesson 3: The Church

Key Truth: The Church is: the People of God, grounded in the Word of God, filled with the Spirit of God, joining in the Mission of God for the Glory of God!

Lesson 4: The Father Heart of God

Key Truth: My identity is now a Son (Daughter) of God. I am no longer a slave to sin or the law but I am free to engage God as my Abba Daddy (Father) and approach the throne of Grace with freedom and confidence.

Lesson 5: The Holy Spirit

Key Truth: Be introduced to the person, work, and indwelling power of the Holy Spirit. Being filled with the Spirit, walking moment by moment in the power of the Holy Spirit.

Lesson 6: Growing Christ-Like

Key Truth: Our purpose and God's plan is for us to be conformed into His image. The sanctification process is a life long pursuit of submitting to the Spirit and following Jesus in obedience.

Lesson 7: The Great Commission

Key Truth: Our call is to follow Jesus and to become disciple makers. Not just disciples, but disciple makers! Jesus invested His life into 12 men and even more specifically, three - Peter, James and John. We are charged with following his example!!

As you look back at Spiritual Boot Camp, can you identify one or more disciples who discipled you?

To be a follower of Jesus is to "go and make disciples, teaching them to obey all that *Christ* has taught you (*the disciple*)." After the seven weeks of Boot Camp have ended, **keep reviewing! Keep asking God** for opportunities to share your faith and use these memorized verses in relationship with others!

Challenge them to pray about who the Lord wants them to share this Good News with and also who they can lead through this Boot Camp, serving as the Discipler.

Reassure them that you are here to assist in any way and that they are totally equipped to do this through the Holy Spirit and His Word.
