II.! Leading the Vision

Each week a different person shares what the church is about, reminding people why we're gathering. <u>Vision leaks</u>, so this is vitally important for every life group meeting. If we don't emphasize the vision, then it's easy for the group to become just a place where we meet our friends, but with little kingdom impact. This time is 1-2 minutes max and reminds everyone why we are gathered.

Here are a few ways to share the vision:

- 1.! Read a scripture passage that speaks to the inward and outward call of the vision of the church. God will work through his Word. See below for suggestions.
- 2.! Use a brief YouTube video or a song that conveys the mission of the church.
- 3.! Have a person share their spiritual growth, family impact, or blessing as they have been in this community. People's testimonies are powerful!
- 4.! Celebrate the group's progress in a key area. Ex. Inviting guests, welcoming new people, blessing kids, stepping out in prayer etc. What gets rewarded gets repeated.

Life Drain Alert: Whoever is speaking the vision, be concise--about 1 minute-otherwise, no one else will think they could ever articulate the vision. Do not go into teacher mode...
