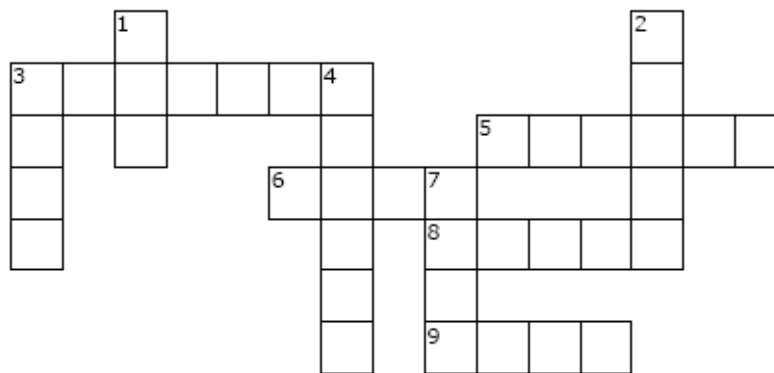

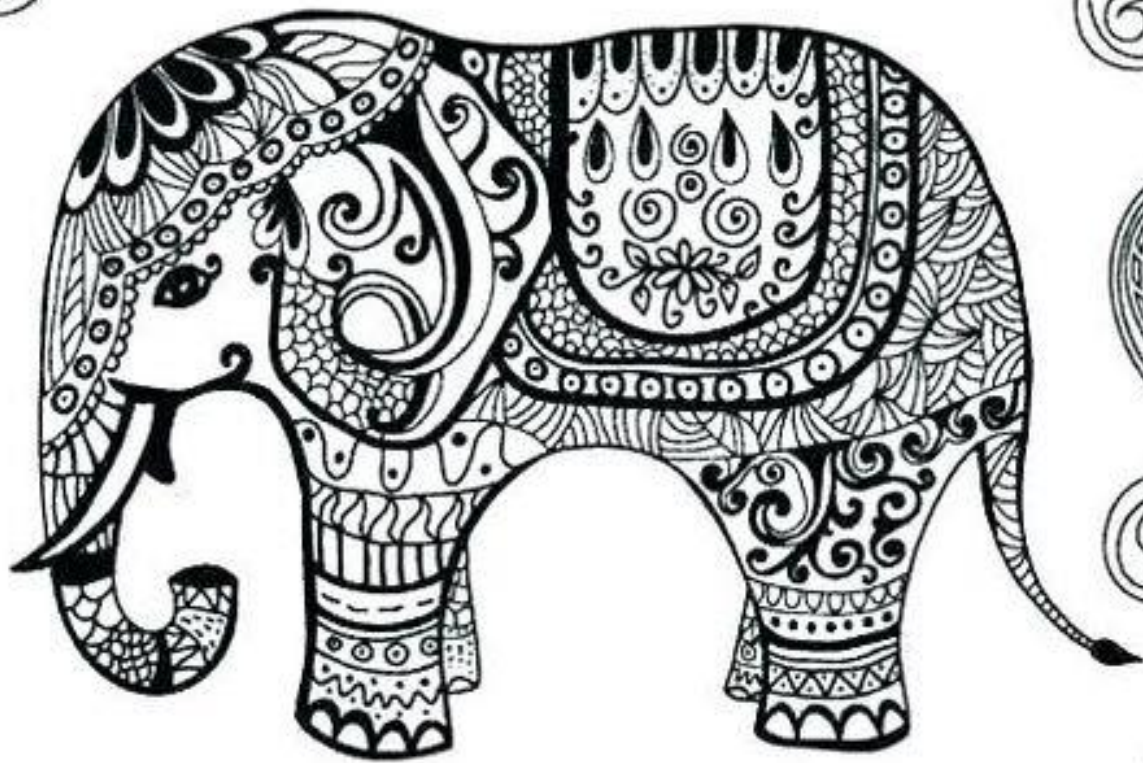
ACROSS

DOWN

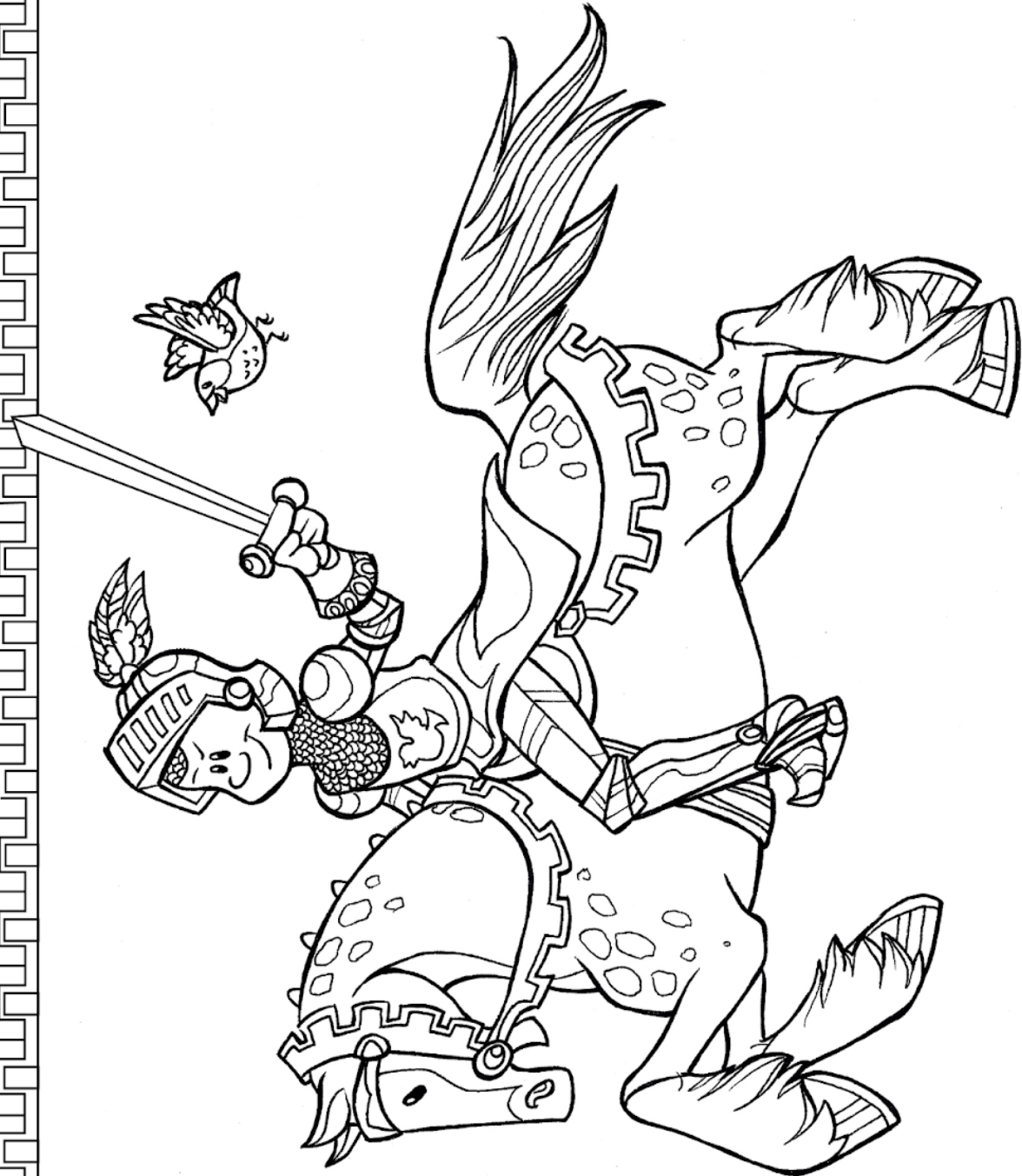
- 1. A period of 24 hours
